# Join us in making history

Morley College London was founded over 130 years ago. Thanks to the vision of Emma Cons and Samuel Morley, our college provides lifelong educational opportunities for diverse communities throughout London.

Emma Cons was an artist, social reformer, and suffragette. She was determined to improve the prospects of the local working community and started lectures for the cost of 1p at what is now known as The Old Vic.

Wool manufacturer and Liberal MP Samuel Morley was a vocal abolitionist and social reformer. He died in 1886 and bequeathed funds to Emma to set up the adult education college she was developing. Morley College was then established in Waterloo in 1889.

In 2020, we expanded to serve the communities of North Kensington and Chelsea. Our higher education programmes are predominantly based at our historic buildings in Waterloo and Chelsea.

# What Level?

Your qualifications are measured in levels. Identifying where you are helps to work out the routes you can take in your chosen vocation, and what level you need to achieve for the job you want. If you don't have any formal qualification, an assessment will match you to the right course.

**Entry Level 1, 2 & 3**

For beginners to gain basic knowledge and skills.

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**L1**

**Level 1**

To gain basic knowledge of jobs, business and industry. L1 is pre GCSE. Puts you on the path to a vocational qualification.

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**L2**

**Level 2 Intermediate**

Courses include diverse range of activities. Certificates and Diplomas for this qualification.

L2 Certificate is 2 GCSEs. L2 Diploma is 4 GCSEs.

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**L3**

**Level 3 Advanced**

Prepares you for work and higher education. More challenge, development of skills and subject knowledge. L3 Certificate is 1 A-Level, L3 Diploma is 1.5 A-levels.

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**L4**

**L5**

**Level 4 & 5  
Higher Education**

Equivalent to the first two years of a degree. Specialist qualification that helps move you into leadership and management.

The Higher National Certificate (HNC) is Level 4.

The Higher National Diploma (HND) is Level 5.

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**L6**

**Level 6**

Equivalent to a degree, with or without honours.

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**L7**

**Level 7**

In-depth professional knowledge, including master's degrees, postgraduate or professional certificates or diplomas.

## Tailoring & Streetwear

### **BTEC Higher National Certificate (HNC) in Tailoring & Streetwear (Level 4)**

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**Centre:** Chelsea

**Cost:** full fee and concession £6,165

This course is one of the few in London, and our focus is on contemporary tailoring and streetwear trends. You will get a fusion of traditional and contemporary skills. We are near the King's Road, with its celebrated history of cultural fashion movements, museums such as the V&A, and Savile Row, the hub of traditional tailoring. We have designed a one-year exciting practical and hands on fashion programme to help you make the most of these opportunities. You will be inspired by our dedicated tutors who are current industry experts in these fields. This is a broad introduction where you will be encouraged to explore, be expressive and experimental by drawing on a range of materials. You will develop a wide range of technical and creative skills preparing you for both industries.

#### **Following this course**

You could progress to studying BTEC HND Tailoring & Streetwear or find work in the industry at entry level.

#### **Entry requirements**

Applicants should have knowledge equivalent to Level 3 fashion. GCSEs grade 4/C+ in maths and English (or an equivalent level of qualification) are desirable. For non-native English speakers, an IELTS 5.5 is required. Applications are welcome by anyone capable of reaching the standards required.

## **BTEC Higher National Diploma (HND) in Tailoring & Streetwear (Level 5)**

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**Centre:** Chelsea

**Cost:** full fee and concession £6,165 (per year)

This course is one of the few in London, and our focus is on contemporary tailoring and streetwear trends. You will get a fusion of traditional and contemporary skills. The streetwear consumer wants affordable exclusivity and is prepared to spend up to five times more on streetwear items compared to non-street wear. We have designed a two-year exciting practical and hands on fashion programme to help you make the most of these opportunities. Close to the King's Road Chelsea, with its celebrated history of cultural fashion movements and several major museums such as the V&A, and Savile Row, the hub of traditional tailoring. You will be inspired by our dedicated tutors who are also current industry experts in these fields. You will develop a wide range of technical and creative skills preparing you for both industries.

### **Following this course**

On successful completion of the HND learners can progress to join the final year of an Honours degree course. Students are also ready to enter the fashion industry setting up their own businesses or competing to be a part of the larger design houses.

### **Entry requirements**

Applicants should have knowledge equivalent to Level 3 fashion. GCSEs grade 4/C+ in maths and English (or an equivalent level of qualification) are desirable. For non-native English speakers, an IELTS 5.5 is required. Applications are welcome from anyone who feels that they can reach the standards required.

# Millinery

## **BTEC Higher National Certificate (HNC) in Millinery (Level 4)**

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**Centre:** Chelsea

**Cost:** full fee and concession £6,165

This course has been training industry-leading milliners for almost 20 years. This one-year programme is designed to give students in-depth experience to prepare them for a career within the industry. The course consists of a series of projects covering different areas of millinery and is designed to develop varied technical skills and expand individual design creativity. Areas covered during the course projects include specialist couture techniques, theatrical millinery, occasion millinery, commercial millinery and cut-and-sew techniques, historical and contextual research, design development skills, blockmaking, portfolio building and professional practice.

### **Following this course**

You could progress to the BTEC HND. Students on this course progress into all areas of millinery — couture fashion millinery, commercial design, theatrical and film millinery. We have close industry links and students have been employed by the UK's leading milliners.

### **Entry requirements**

Applicants should have knowledge equivalent to Level 3 fashion. GCSEs grade 4/C+ in maths and English (or an equivalent level of qualification) are desirable. For non-native English speakers, an IELTS 5.5 is required. Applications are welcome by anyone capable of reaching the standards required.

## BTEC Higher National Diploma (HND) in Millinery (Level 5)

**Centre:** Chelsea

**Cost:** full fee and concession £6,165 (per year)

The HND Millinery course has been training industry-leading milliners for almost 20 years. This two-year programme is designed to give students in-depth millinery experience to prepare them for a career within the industry. The course consists of a series of projects to develop varied technical skills and expand each students' individual design creativity. Areas covered during the course projects include specialist couture techniques, theatrical millinery, occasion millinery, commercial millinery and cut-and-sew techniques, historical and contextual research, design development skills, blockmaking, portfolio building and professional practice. The tutors are all professional milliners and bring a wealth of diversity, skills and ideas to aid the development of different career pathways for each student.

### Following this course

Former students have gained employment with the UK's leading milliners, established their own businesses, or progressed onto BA and MA courses at leading fashion colleges. You could progress into all areas of millinery — couture fashion millinery, commercial design, theatrical and film millinery.

### Entry requirements

You will be asked to attend an interview with a portfolio of creative work. Learners should have previous millinery experience although applicants with a variety of other art and design skills will be considered.

# Fine Art

## **BTEC Higher National Certificate (HNC) in Fine Art (Level 4)**

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**Centre:** Chelsea

**Cost:** full fee and concession £6,165

It offers you the opportunity to specialise and refine your professional practice in a supportive and stimulating environment. You will have a personal tutor and a dedicated studio space. You will be coached and supported to extend your technical skills, and your body of work. You will take part in guided visits to exhibitions and galleries and will experience a broad range of workshop demonstrations to develop your skills. The HNC will give you the confidence to progress your ideas, make your mark, build a body of work, and strengthen your talent as a professional and exhibiting artist.

### **Following this course**

You could study the BTEC (HND) in Fine Art (Level 5) at Morley or at another college.

### **Entry requirements**

Good level of maths and English; basic computer skills; portfolio of work.

## **BTEC Higher National Diploma (HND) in Fine Art (Level 5)**

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**Centre:** Chelsea

**Cost:** full fee and concession £6,165 (per year)

This is a two-year course, nationally recognised and equivalent to the first two years of a university degree. It offers you the opportunity to further specialise and refine your professional practise in a supportive and stimulating environment. You will be allocated a personal tutor and a dedicated studio space, and will be coached and supported to extend your technical skills and strengthen your body of work. You will take part in guided visits to exhibitions and galleries. The HND will give you the confidence to progress your ideas, make your mark in the context of current practice. Tutors will support you in building a body of work that can best represent your vision, strengths and talents as a professional and exhibiting artist.

### **Following this course**

You could study a Fine Art BA (Hons) degree at Morley or at another college.

### **Entry requirements**

Applicants should have Level 4 HNC in the subject, as the HND is a continuation of the HNC course.

## BA (Hons) in Fine Art (Top-up) (Level 6)

**Centre:** Chelsea

**Cost:** full fee and concession £6,165

The top-up degree programme has been designed for students who have successfully completed an HND or Foundation degree in a relevant subject and now wish to convert their existing qualification into a full BA Honours qualification in the heart of London. This BA Honours top-up will teach you how to evaluate different critical approaches to your own research, through integrated studio practice and critical studies courses. The programme will help you unleash your creativity through a broad range of technical tools, experiences, and resources. This dynamic and thought-provoking course is taught by a team of dedicated tutors with current industry experience. The programme provides excellent quality higher education in fine art, which fosters flexibility, a multidisciplinary approach, and embraces diversity. The course will provide learning opportunities for experimentation, collaboration and enjoyment of artists working in varied fields and media.

### Following this course

On successful completion of this course, you will achieve a Fine Art BA (Hons) degree. You could go on to study a master's, practise art and find employment suited to your skills and interests.

### Entry requirements

This course is equivalent to the third year of a university degree. Applicants are expected to have completed an HND or Foundation degree in art and design (or related discipline). You also need a good level of writing skills and basic computer skills.

# Illustration, Drawing & Printmaking



# Illustration, Drawing & Printmaking

## **BTEC Higher National Certificate (HNC) in Illustration, Drawing & Printmaking (Level 4)**

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**Centre:** Chelsea

**Cost:** full fee and concession £6,165

This is a one-year course that allows you to interrogate 2D practices across a range of traditional and cutting-edge processes. With a focus on hands-on, process-based expertise, the course develops your skills with a range of primarily 2D practices and interrogation into each method to develop and refine work to understand the intricacies of each production method. The course focuses on commercial practices which can be applied to a range of specialist pathways, so an understanding of your area of focus (such as Illustration or surface print) is an advantage. You are required to work independently outside of sessions to utilise time in studio effectively.

### **Following this course**

On successful completion of this course, you could apply to study the BTEC HND in Illustration, Drawing & Printmaking.

### **Entry requirements**

48 UCAS points or a creative subject qualification such as, Access to Higher Education Diploma, A Levels, or a Level 3 Extended Diploma. GCSE English Grade 4/C+; GCSE maths is desirable.

## **BTEC Higher National Diploma (HND) in Illustration, Drawing & Printmaking (Level 5)**

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**Centre:** Chelsea

**Cost:** full fee and concession £6,165 (per year)

This two-year course is developed to enable its students to interrogate 2D practices across a range of both traditional and cutting-edge processes. With a focus on hands-on, process-based expertise, the course is designed to develop your skills and knowledge of a broad range of primarily 2D practices, with interrogation into each method so you can test, develop and refine your work to understand the various intricacies of each production method. At Level 5 study, we aim for you to develop as a specialist, so your briefs will allow you to respond to what drives your work, and focus on what matters most to you. As this course is broad and experimental in its approach, you will be able to develop your work depending on your own personal direction.

### **Following this course**

On successful completion of this course, you could apply to study a BA (Hons) degree course.

### **Entry requirements**

Entry is established at 48 UCAS points equivalent achieved through either Access to Higher Education Diploma, A levels or a BTEC at Level 3. In addition: GCSE English Grade 4+. GCSE maths is desirable. Applications for direct entry onto the second year of study can be made by those who have an associated HNC at Level 4.

# Graphic Design



## Graphic Design

### **BTEC Higher National Certificate (HNC) in Graphic Design (Level 4)**

**Centre:** Chelsea

**Cost:** full fee and concession £6,165

The HNC in Art & Design (Graphic Design) is a one year course designed to provide students with a broad ranging experience of this ever-evolving subject area. The course is aimed at those who wish to work as professional graphic designers. This industry has exhibited growth over the past five years, especially in areas such as digital advertising, website design and digital design services. This course will help you to develop and extend your creative practice as a designer by providing you with a wide range of experiences such as working with clients, exhibiting your work, engaging with industry focused projects and competitions. You will study graphics related techniques, contextual studies, typography, packaging and printmaking during the course. You will work towards an end of year exhibition at our Chelsea centre during year one. You will be supported via tutorials and regular contact with the course team.

#### **Following this course**

You could progress to the BTEC HND in Graphic Design or find work in the industry at entry level.

#### **Entry requirements**

Applicants should have 48 UCAS points equivalent achieved through an Access to Higher Education Diploma, A levels, or BTEC at Level 3 in a related area. GCSE English language grade 4 or C minimum, GCSE maths is desirable.

## **BTEC Higher National Diploma (HND) in Graphic Design (Level 5)**

**Centre:** Chelsea

**Cost:** full fee and concession £6,165 (per year)

This is a full-time two year course aimed at those who wish to work as professional graphic designers. This industry has exhibited growth over the past five years, especially in areas such as digital advertising, website design and digital design services. This course will help you to develop and extend your creative practice as a designer by providing you with a wide range of experiences such as working with clients, exhibiting your work, engaging with industry focused projects and competitions.

You will study graphics related techniques, contextual studies, typography, packaging and printmaking during year one of the course. Year two will include opportunities to explore professional practice, web design, art direction, branding and identity. You will work towards an end of year exhibition and we intend to participate in the D&AD New Blood Festival in London as a culmination of your studies in the second year.

### **Following this course**

You could progress to study a BA Hons degree top-up year in graphic design or graphic communication, or find employment in the industry.

### **Entry requirements**

Applicants should have 48 UCAS points equivalent achieved through an Access to Higher Education Diploma, A levels, or BTEC at Level 3 in a related area. GCSE English language grade 4 or C minimum, GCSE maths is desirable.

# Photography



# Photography

## **BTEC Higher National Certificate (HNC) in Photography (Level 4)**

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**Centre:** Chelsea

**Cost:** full fee and concession £6,165

This one-year course provides a competitive edge, offering in-depth practical and theoretical explorations into current practices in conceptual, editorial and commercial photography. You will build knowledge studying eight units. You will explore practical aspects of photography and acquire extensive skills in studio lighting, industry based digital post production, analogue photography, and black and white darkroom printing. The theoretical units provide a historical and cultural framework to deepen your understanding of photography in a wider context. You will develop collaborative working, problem solving and communication skills. Our group sizes are small. Our close-knit team of specialist staff will coach in professional practice, helping you to find your voice and develop a strong portfolio.

### **Following this course**

You could progress to the BTEC HND in Photography or find work in the industry at entry level.

### **Entry requirements**

Applicants should have knowledge equivalent to a Level 3 photography programme. GCSEs grade 4/C+ in maths and English (or equivalent) are desirable. For non-native English speakers, an IELTS 5.5 is required. A digital portfolio of your own photographic work (16-20 images) to present/discuss in your online interview.

## **BTEC Higher National Diploma (HND) in Photography (Level 5)**

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**Centre:** Chelsea

**Cost:** full fee and concession £6,165 (per year)

The programme has a clear emphasis on professional development and the creation of a strong portfolio. The interaction of technical, theoretical and creative aspects of photography is central in the delivery of the HND programme, with the focus of keeping up to date with the rapidly evolving photography industry. This course offers space to develop styles and direction, through in-depth and hands-on exploration of current techniques and trends in photographic practice. Learning takes place in small groups, with one-to-one support in our state-of-the-art studio and darkroom and enriched by gallery visits. Inspirational lecturers with professional experience will help you complete six units to create and successfully manage ambitious photography projects. You will expand your skills in studio lighting, digital post-production, analogue photography and black and white darkroom printing. You will also explore branding, identity and a historical and cultural framework that will broaden your understanding of photography.

### **Following this course**

You could progress to a degree course in photography or find employment in the industry.

### **Entry requirements**

Applicants should have Level 4 HNC, as the Higher National Diploma (HND) is a continuation of the HNC course. GCSEs grade 4/C+ in maths and English or equivalent are desirable. For non-native English speakers, an IELTS 5.5 is required. You will also need a digital portfolio to present/discuss in your interview.

### BTEC Higher National Certificate (HNC) in Fashion (Level 4)

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**Centre:** Waterloo

**Cost:** full fee and concession £6,165

To recognise and to foster talent; these are the founding principles at the heart of the undergraduate fashion courses at Morley College London's Waterloo Centre. Our courses have a strongly demonstrated ethos of inclusivity and collaboration, creating a rich learning environment in which to realise your vision and provide you with the core skills needed to navigate the challenging, fluctuating landscape of fashion now. You could study the BTEC HND Fashion course or begin work in the industry at entry level.

#### Entry requirements

Applicants should have knowledge equivalent to Level 3 fashion or a related discipline. GCSEs grade 4/C+ in maths and English (or an equivalent level of qualification) are desirable. For non-native English speakers, an IELTS 5.5 is required. We offer places based on a portfolio, and all students are expected to have a good standard of computer literacy.

## **BTEC Higher National Diploma (HND) in Fashion (Level 5)**

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**Centre:** Waterloo

**Cost:** full fee and concession £6,165 (per year)

The HND Art & Design (Fashion) will enable you to push the boundaries of your creativity through research and experimentation, underpinned by a solid foundation of technical skills to help you realise your vision. Throughout the course, you will complete design portfolios and capsule collections to professional standards reinforced by signature branding and marketing materials in preparation for further study or a career within the industry. Explore a range of influences in support of your individual interests, including women's luxury ready to wear, bespoke tailoring, or costume design and construction. Our team of industry professional lecturers and technicians impart their wealth of knowledge to the next generation through exciting projects based on real world scenarios across a range of fashion related disciplines.

### **Following this course**

You could progress onto the BA (Hons) Fashion course at Morley or begin employment in the industry.

### **Entry requirements**

Applicants should have knowledge equivalent to Level 3 fashion or a related discipline. GCSEs grade 4/C+ in maths and English (or an equivalent level of qualification) are desirable. For non-native English speakers, an IELTS 5.5 is required. We offer places based on a portfolio, and all students are expected to have a good standard of computer literacy.

## **BA (Hons) Fashion (Top-up) (Level 6)**

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**Centre:** Waterloo

**Cost:** full fee and concession £6,165

This exciting course will allow you to define your place within the rapidly changing world of fashion. Opportunities to develop professional skills through independent and collaborative projects will enable you to explore, experiment, refine and evaluate your own practice and gain a deeper understanding of the industry in preparation for your fashion career. Each of the specialist course units provides the time and space for a comprehensive exploration of creative concept themes supported by academic research in the completion of your fully realized graduate collection. A final exhibition combining conceptual and commercial outcomes provides potential for you to engage with the public through a presentation or retail setting.

### **Following this course**

You could progress to a master's course in Fashion or begin employment in the industry.

### **Entry requirements**

Applicants will normally be expected to have one of the following in Fashion or Textiles: A Level 5 National Diploma or equivalent UK or international qualification. You will need evidence of prior learning or industry related work, research and design work or practical skills in garment construction, pattern cutting, prototyping, and related digital programmes. We offer places based on a portfolio, and all students are expected to have a good standard of computer literacy.

# Ceramics

## **BTEC Higher National Certificate (HNC) in Ceramics (Level 4)**

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**Centre:** Waterloo

**Cost:** full fee and concession £6,165

The HNC is a one-year course, three taught days per week: Wednesdays, Thursdays and Fridays, with additional workshop hours.

On our HNC Ceramics course, you will develop a wide range of practical clay construction, mould making and digital design skills, inspired and guided by a team of subject specialist tutors. Our small group sizes ensure maximum contact time with tutors, fostering students to push the boundaries of personal creativity. Our ceramics, mould-making and design studios include industry-standard equipment to enable students to explore technologies and gain hands on knowledge of ceramic materials and techniques. Students can exhibit work throughout the year as well as at the end of year exhibition, which celebrates student achievements.

### **Following this course**

You could study the BTEC HND in Ceramics at Morley and will have a wide-ranging portfolio to begin a creative career path if desired.

### **Entry requirements**

We welcome applications from anyone capable of reaching the standards required. We offer places based on a portfolio and/or experience.

## **BTEC Higher National Diploma (HND) in Ceramics (Level 5)**

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**Centre:** Waterloo

**Cost:** full fee and concession £6,165 (per year)

The HND is a two-year course; the first year is Wednesday, Thursday, Friday and the second year is taught on Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday. Our HND Ceramics course will make sure students gain professional practical and design skills to support future careers in ceramics. Alongside advanced clay-construction and mould-making skills, students will establish conceptual confidence, inspired and guided by a team of subject specialist tutors. Our small group sizes ensure maximum support and tuition for each student to ensure the best possible progress and achievement. Our HND specialist ceramics, mould-making and design studios are equipped with industry standard digital and practical equipment to enable students to utilise technologies alongside deepening knowledge of ceramic materials and techniques.

### **Following this course**

By the end of the course, students will have developed a personal creative vocabulary incorporating knowledge of ceramic materials and will have an extensive portfolio. Previous students have set up their own ceramic studios and practices, progressed to BA courses and onto an MA ceramics course.

### **Entry requirements**

We welcome applications from anyone capable of reaching the standards required by the qualification. We offer places based on a portfolio and/or experience. All students are expected to have a basic standard of computer literacy.

# Music



## Music: Performance or Production

### **BTEC Higher National Certificate (HNC) in Music Performance or Production (Level 4)**

**Centre:** Waterloo

**Cost:** full fee and concession £6,165

The HNC is a one-year course, with lessons three days a week. Music is closely tied to our history, from our connections to classical composers Gustav Holst, Michael Tippett and Ralph Vaughan Williams, to our well-established choirs, jazz bands and orchestra. We have excellent studio facilities including an SSL-based recording studio. Take part in workshops, ensembles and concerts, with opportunities to visit festivals and gigs backstage. The course is modular, allowing you to customise your journey. Activities include technical work such as studio production, sound design, live sound, and composition for film. You'll cover aural training, composition, song writing, solo and band performance and more. You'll put principles of music, events management, business, and marketing into practice.

#### **Following this course**

You could progress to studying the BTEC HND in Music at Morley.

#### **Entry requirements**

We welcome anyone capable of reaching the standards required by the qualification. Mature students may have extensive experience. If you have recently been in education: a relevant Level 3 qualification or GCSE, or an Access to Higher Education Diploma.

## **BTEC Higher National Diploma (HND) in Music (Performance or Production) (Level 5)**

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**Centre:** Waterloo

**Cost:** full fee and concession £6,165 (per year)

The HND in Music has two different pathways with the HNC being one year of study and the HND taking two years. You can specialise in either Music Performance (including song writing, theory, performance and band), or Music Production (including electronic music, studio engineering, live sound). Music is closely tied to our history, from our connections to classical composers Gustav Holst, Michael Tippett and Ralph Vaughan Williams, to our well-established choirs, jazz bands and orchestra. We have excellent studio facilities, and you'll participate workshops, ensembles and concerts, as well as exciting opportunities to visit festivals and gigs backstage. Course activities include technical work such as studio production, sound design, live sound, and composition for film. You'll cover musical elements including aural training, composition, song writing, and solo and band performance. You'll put into practice principles of music business, marketing, and events management.

### **Following this course**

You could progress to the BA (Hons) Music (Performance or Production) or find employment in the industry.

### **Entry requirements**

A Level 3 qualification in music performance or music production (A Level, BTEC National Diploma or equivalent); Access to HE qualification in music; other related Level 3 (or higher) qualification. GCSE English grade 4 or C+, GCSE maths is desirable.

## **BA (Hons) Music (Performance or Production) (Top-up) (Level 6)**

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**Centre:** Waterloo

**Cost:** full fee and concession £6,165

This exciting new BA (Hons) degree course is a one-year programme designed to enable those with an HND, Foundation degree or DipHE qualification to convert to a full degree in either Music Performance or Production. The course will incorporate a range of units including thought-provoking exploration into musical philosophy and research, expansion of your creative ideas in sound art or technological performance and advanced technical work in your chosen discipline. You will gain experience in collaborative work with college projects such as the new Morley Radio station, Morley's TERM Records or with external partners. Most importantly, you will determine the nature of your major research and creative projects, allowing you to shape your course and the direction of your future career whilst mentored by a team of expert tutors. You will take part in Morley's rich and vibrant music culture, play in our ensembles, make use of our fantastic facilities, and broaden your horizons with short courses, production visits and industry seminars.


### **Following this course**

You could progress to a master's course or find employment in the industry.

### **Entry requirements**

Students will normally be expected to hold at least one of the following (or equivalent) UK or international qualifications of the value of 120 credits at Level 4 and 120 credits at Level 5 in a subject related to music: BTEC HND; FdA (Foundation degree), DipHE.

# Drama



## Performing Arts

### **BTEC Higher National Certificate (HNC) in Performing Arts (Acting) (Level 4)**

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**Centre:** Waterloo

**Cost:** full fee and concession £6,165

During this one-year course you will work on a series of projects, fine-tuning your talents to rehearse and collaborate with others and performing a diverse range of work in front of live audiences. Morley has a long history as a cultural player in the performing arts and has a team of experienced tutors who are professionals in their field and experienced in enabling you, as an adult learner, to develop your skills towards employability in this diverse and growing industry. During this course, you will train in acting, movement, voice (for stage, screen and radio), singing, puppetry and acting for camera. These abilities are applied in a devising project in the third term under professional conditions in a live performance.

#### **Following this course**

You could progress to study the HND in Performing Arts at Morley as well as progress to a range of careers in the performing arts industry.

#### **Entry requirements**

We welcome anyone capable of reaching the standards required by the qualification. Mature students may have extensive experience. If you have recently been in education: a relevant Level 3 qualification or GCSE, or an Access to Higher Education Diploma. Applicants will be asked to attend either a workshop-style audition in person or a 1-1 audition online.

## **BTEC Higher National Diploma (HND) in Performing Arts (Acting) (Level 5)**

**Centre:** Waterloo

**Cost:** full fee and concession £6,165 (per year)

This two-year course is designed to prepare you for a career as a professional performer. The first year is the HNC (see page before). The second year (HND) provides a practical, vocational education and encourages intellectual and personal growth through a programme of training and study. It also enhances imagination, bravery and creativity. You will develop your acting skills in more depth and go on to rehearse and perform in a scripted play to an invited audience of family, friends and industry guests. You will expand your reflective processes and analytical abilities, and enrich your individual creativity and imagination in a research project. There is a strong emphasis on independent learning, self-management and communication skills. Over the two years you will gain skills to prepare you for a portfolio career in the performing arts industry, to ensure you have a sustainable future as an actor.

### **Following this course**

You could progress to the final year of a bachelor's degree in the subject, start your own business, or go into employment in the industry or teaching.

### **Entry requirements**

We welcome anyone capable of reaching the standards required by the qualification. Mature students may have extensive experience. If you have recently been in education: a relevant Level 3 qualification or GCSE, or an Access to Higher Education Diploma. Applicants will be asked to attend a workshop-style audition.

## **BTEC Higher National Certificate (HNC) in Business (Level 4)**

**Cost:** full fee and concession £6,165

### Entry requirements

Level 3 early years qualification (or equivalent), employment in an appropriate setting (either paid or voluntary) for at least 16 hours per week for the duration of the course and two years' experience in an appropriate early years' setting.
