Thank you for your interest in applying for the role of **Director of Digital Transformation Delivery** at Morley College London.

Although the College has been around for more than 100 years we are still in the early stages of our journey of digital transformation, and this role provides the opportunity to help us successfully navigate the challenges and unlock the huge potential benefits that digital transformation can bring to the communities we serve, and to shape the way that this is achieved.

Morley itself has a rich history, dating back to its founding by suffragette Emma Cons in 1889. And, in fact, going back even further thanks to the *Penny Lectures* series – first one delivered in 1882. You'll work closely too with the Senior Leadership Team, particularly with the Chief Planning and Data Officer, ensuring the alignment of implementation of the digital strategy with the College's aspirations for data integration and reporting, and the impact of Artificial Intelligence, ensuring the immense variety and diversity of the Morley experience effectively supports the needs of the next generation of students.

Based in our Waterloo Centre, but performing a cross-college function, you will play a leading role in ensuring the security and resilience of the College's systems, reflecting the increased cyber security risks faced by the sector, preparing for the worst while actively ensuring that this doesn't happen.

Having completed the renovation of both the North Kensington and Chelsea Centres, we are about to embark on a multi-million pound renovation of the Waterloo Centre for Adult Education, a significant investment in Morley's Higher Education curriculum, supported by the ongoing profile raising of the college in the wake of its 2020 merger and expansion. This role will be pivotal in determining and implementing the upgrade of network infrastructure as part of this project.
